



Patient Non-Discrimination Policy

Steps to Recovery will not discriminate against any person based on their age, race, creed, sex, ethnicity, color, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity / expression, handicap or religion.

Equal Visitation Policy

- Steps to Recovery will not restrict or limit visitation based on age, race, creed, sex, ethnicity, color, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity / expression, handicap or religion.
- All visitors must present as drug/alcohol abuse free and must have a vested interest in the client's well being.
- All visitors must leave personal belongings including handbags, cell-phones, laptops, iPads, energy drinks and other banned items in their cars. If you cannot do so please discuss with the Program Manager and arrangements for storage of these items will be made.
- Prior to entering the facility or engaging with Steps to Recovery employees or clients in any way, all visitors must read and sign the 'Equal Visitation Policy and Confidentiality Agreement'.
- Visitors must wear a name badge and be accompanied by Steps to Recovery staff at all times unless granted an exemption due to relevant circumstances.
